DECLARATION OF QUORUM

The meeting was called to order by President Kelly Sengstock at 3:37 pm. Quorum was established with three (3) Board Members present in person and one (3) by livestream.

EMERGENCY BUSINESS

Redistricting: Karen Perry presented a “Proposed Election Precincts and Proposed 2022 Legislative Districts Redistricting Plan B”. Ms. Perry explained all changes due to the new Councilmanic and Legislative lines. These are outlined on the attached spreadsheet. The purpose of creating a Plan B was due the passing of Senate Bill 158 requiring local election offices to have the same number of “precinct polling places” as 2018. She also stated that due to pending litigation, this plan could change and must be rewritten and presented. If no changes are made by the courts, the Board will be required to approve (sign-off) the presented plan.

MOTION: Nancy Simpers motioned to approve the “Proposed Election Precincts and Proposed 2022 Legislative Districts Redistricting Plan B”, as presented.

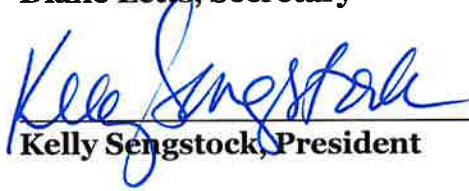
ADJOURNMENT
