- Friends of Cecil County Parks & Recreation Update: Provided by Thomas McFadden. Upcoming events: Brantwood Blooms, Cecil Springs, Arts in the Parks. Brantwood Blooms is partnering with Elementary Schools, the Teens Give Back program at the Cecil County Public Library and possibly the Tome School. Fifty-Two flats of plants are ready to go. A walk through to check planting areas at Brantwood is taking place this Friday, 3/18. Volunteers from the Fair Hill Nature Center and Master Gardeners will also be assisting in the project. On May 11th there will be a planting a tree event. Two-hour blocks are available for volunteers on May 7th, 14th and 21st.
