Open Meeting Minutes

June 27, 2023

Present: Stephen Miller, Robert McKnight, Jamila Mettee, Rodney Heinze,

Call to Order:

- The meeting was called to order at 11:00 a.m.
- Roll call - 4 members present, representing a quorum. (Michael Dawson absent)
- Pledge of Allegiance

Agenda Approval:

- Update to the Agenda to include the Pledge of Allegiance. Chairman Miller made a motion to approve the amended agenda, seconded by Jamila Mettee. Motion approved by a vote of 4 to 0.

Old Business:

- Correction to the minutes, Robert McKnight is the chairman, not Steve Miller.
- On a motion made by Jamila Mettee, seconded by Rodney Heinze, the Board moved to approve the amended minutes of the May 30, 2023. The motion was approved unanimously.

New Business:

- Discussion of Law Enforcement and their internal investigations. The PAB will accept internal investigations regarding use of force submitted by law enforcement agencies.
- Review of 3 investigatory files (2023-A, 2022-37 and 2023-49)

Closed Session:

- Chairman Robert McKnight announced his intention for the Committee to enter into a closed session pursuant to the Maryland Annotated Code, General provisions for §3-305 to review 3 investigatory files.
- On a motion made by Jamila Mettee, and seconded by Steve Miller, the Committee moved to convene a closed session, pursuant to the Maryland Annotated Code, General Provisions §3-305 to review files 2023-A, 2022-37 and 2023-49.
- Roll call vote. The motion was approved unanimously by a vote of 4 to 0.
- The ACC went into Closed Session at 11:10 am.
- The ACC returned to the Elk Room at 1:00 pm.
- On a motion by Jamila Mettee to reopen the closed session, and seconded by Steve Miller, the ACC meeting was reopened.
